

## "OTHER NOTABLE SHADOW DEMI-PLANES"

## #4: MIDNIGHT MIRRORS

**M**IDNIGHT MIRRORS are magickael prisonns, made as a blessing from ye LORDE OF YE SHADOWES, ZONN-KUTHON. ye church of ye selfsame deitie useth such relicks for ye punifment of those who BLASPHEME AND REBEL gainst authoritie lawfull. Ye MIDNIGHT MIRRORS consist and contain of a place beyond ye plane materiæl. Inside of ye MIRRORS, ye prissonner agest not and diest not, but experiencest and seest each day as it passst being trapped withinn for eternitie of tormet and suffering. Ye MIRROR is inescapable and impregnable with three exceptionnes.

FIRSTE: Eache MIDNIGHT MIRROR can be commended with a worde to release a prissonner from within.

SECONDE: A willinge



ftuff ye demiplane of ye mirrore is made. Mine notes on ye plane of shadowes earlyer in this volume represent ye truthe of ye thing.

The people of NIDAL, who look upon their fellows who do not worship ZONN-KUTHON as creatures of an inferior naturre, and all the rest of ye species as something les than humann, are the onnes who create these relicks.

They take or purchasest a looking-glass, a mirrore, or any piece of polished metall or silvered glass. Then, upon the even' of a newe moon, ye shadowecallers of ZONN-KUTHON take blades of silvere unto their wrists, and spill their life-bloode upon its surface. They beckonne forth fromm ye plane of shadowes a creature of great power, a *tendriculus tenebrous* that will take up residence withinn ye mirrore, becoming ye *COR DE VITRUM*.

subject may exchange hes bodie with a person fo trapped inside ye MIRROR. THIS actionn is most commonly taken by ye holy torturrers and clericks of ZONN-KUTHON in their experience of another personn's suffring and paine.

THIRD: EVERY MIRROR containst at its corre, a HEART of YE MIRROR. THIS *COR DE VITRUM* one sees not beyond ye plane of shadowes, and is ye very manifestationne of ye MIRROR withinn itself. It may not be destroyed but with a fragment shard of ye MIRROR from ye plane materiæl. It is this creature, ye cor de vitrum, that shapest the reality within.

YE ADVENTURRER BE WARNED: to shatter ye MIRROR representst great dangerr, as suche an acte bringest ye plane of shadowes and ye plane materiæl closer. Ye area around, fore a distance of manye leagues, will be subfumed in a magickæl darknesse untill ye *COR DE VITRUM* is destroyed.

Beware, ye who enterr ye mirrore. It bears traits of ye greater plane of shadowes, of which

ye *COR DE VITRUM* may reare up to a heighte of 15 feet. my initialle observations indicatest a weight of about 3,500 librim.

It has an uncannie abilitie to grab and hold. If it may hold ye affailante, it may try to swallow it withinn, dissolving it in stronge acid.

Ye *COR DE VITRUM* can be dammaged with any magickæl weaponn, but very soone regeneratest itself unless dammaged with a shard of ye mirrore.
